Please accept this letter as official notice to the British Columbia Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) and to the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) that:

- The name of the Project has been changed from WesPac Tilbury Marine Jetty to Tilbury Marine Jetty Project; and
- Tilbury Jetty Limited Partnership is replacing WesPac Midstream-Vancouver LLC as the Proponent.

Tilbury Jetty Limited Partnership will continue working with the EAO on the ongoing assessment. That assessment is being conducted under the *Environmental Assessment Act 2002* and continues as a substituted assessment under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012*.
