Re: Determination of Administrative Penalty

Further to the Initial Notice Prior to Determination of Administrative Penalty issued to you on December 31, 2021 and the opportunity to respond on January 21, 2022, the calculation of the Administrative Penalty (AP) is now \$72,500.

After reviewing the available information, I have concluded that Coastal GasLink Pipeline Ltd. has failed to comply with Enforcement Order EN2020-011 issued under Section 53(1) of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (2018) (the Act); in respect of which, an administrative penalty is being imposed pursuant to Section 60 of the Act and the Administrative Penalties (*Environmental Assessment Act*) Regulation. The reasons for my decision, and payment details are provided in the attached decision document.

Opportunity to Review

The Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) has determined that for administrative penalties greater than \$25,000 it will provide parties with an opportunity to have the work conducted by the EAO reviewed by the Chief Executive Assessment Officer (CEAO). Please confirm in writing (via email) within seven days of receipt of this notice if you would like to request a review by the CEAO. If I do not hear from you within seven calendar days, I will assume that you do not wish to avail yourself of this opportunity and the AP amount of \$72,500 will be due in accordance with the timing indicated in the attached decision document.
