## **ORDER TRANSFERRING A CERTIFICATE**

- A. On April 20, 2022, the Minister of Environment and Climate Change Strategy and the Minister of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation issued a Certificate to Vopak Development Canda Inc. to construct and operate the Project, a bulk liquids tank storage facility located on Ridley Island approximately 1.6 kilometres (km) west of Port Edward and 10.5 km south of Prince Rupert, British Columbia.

Certificate and is responsible for complying with all terms and conditions of the Certificate.

1) I transfer the Certificate from Vopak Development Canada Inc. to Ridley Island Energy Export Facility GP Inc., on behalf of Ridley Island Energy Export Facility Limited Partnership, effective as of the date this Order is signed.
