ORDER TRANSFERRING A CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS:

- A. On April 20, 2022, the Minister of Environment and Climate Change Strategy and the Minister of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation issued a Certificate to Vopak Development Canada Inc. to construct and operate the Project, a bulk liquids tank storage facility located on Ridley Island approximately 1.6 kilometres (km) west of Port Edward and 10.5 km south of Prince Rupert, British Columbia.
- B. On November 8, 2023, Vopak Development Canada Inc. applied to the Chief Executive Assessment Officer to transfer the Certificate to Ridley Island Energy Export Facility GP Inc., on behalf of Ridley Island Energy Export Facility Limited Partnership, under Section 33(1) of the Act.
- C. The date for the transfer is immediate upon issuance of this Order.
- D. As a result of this Order, Ridley Island Energy Export Facility GP Inc., on behalf of Ridley Island Energy Export Facility Limited Partnership, is the Holder of the

Certificate and is responsible for complying with all terms and conditions of the Certificate.

NOW THEREFORE:

I order as follows:

- 1) I transfer the Certificate from Vopak Development Canada Inc. to Ridley Island Energy Export Facility GP Inc., on behalf of Ridley Island Energy Export Facility Limited Partnership, effective as of the date this Order is signed.
